

ELECTRONICS RECYCLING

Due to recent changes with our electronics vendor, we are no longer able to take electronics from communities/businesses outside of our SOCRRA communities.

SOCRRA takes electronics from our 12 SOCRRA member communities (please check our website for a list of communities), and from our customers of Bingham Farms, Bloomfield Hills and City of Rochester (Rochester residents must purchase a voucher from their city office).

The following is a list of companies that will take electronics from residents/businesses outside of SOCRRA:

- a. Great Lakes Electronics – www.ewaste1.com – Sterling Heights – 888-392-7831- Takes computers, monitors, terminals, printed circuit boards, telephone equipment, TV's, VCR's and communications systems.
- b. eCycle Opportunities – www.ecycleopps.org – 248-233-4477 – Takes computers and electronics, cell phones, communications equipment, DVD players, laptops, monitors*, miscellaneous office machines, PDA's and handheld games, printers, servers, routers and hubs, televisions*, stereo and audio components, VCRs and Holiday lights.

*There is a \$25 fee for all televisions and a \$10 fee for non-flat screen computer monitors. The fee will be waived for each monitor that comes with an accompanying computer. The fees do not cover the entire expense of recycling the materials, but help defray costs so they can continue accepting those items.

- c. Motor City Free Geek – www.motorcityfreegeek.net – Takes donated electronic hardware: computers, cell phones, PDA's and other personal electronics. They refurbish and grant to schools and charitable organizations.
- d. Staples – www.staples.com – Please check their website for a complete list of equipment. They do not take TV's.
