Holiday Collection Changes:

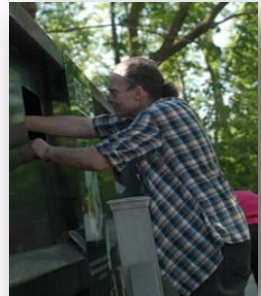
Recycling and trash collection will be delayed 1 day during July 4-8.
